SIEC Update – No meeting

*WMLEC Gap Solutions* –The specialty cables are ordered, and Motorola will schedule the upgrades to the RapidComm Trailer soon.

CMED Hovey Hill – The project is out to bid.

*Holcomb Road Project* –Green Mountain Company will contact Bob Garriety to plan a date to get to the site once the weather improves.

*COMU Go Kits* –Jason Breault agreed to provide Raine with the specific details on the miscellaneous connecting cables for the procurement specifications.

### Western Mass Interoperable Systems Update

Berkshire County – BC is waiting on the radio console upgrades.

Franklin County – Walter Tibbets updated the committee on some tower microwave equipment repairs, and noted that the Radio System Manager is doing a great job identifying some system

problems in the field. There are ongoing discussions on available radio systems options, and the viability of migrating to the Commonwealth 800 MHz radio system. EOPSS will provide more details on the costs involved.

*Hampshire County* – Matt Barstow reported on the ATT upgrades at the Goshen tower, and the possible communication systems impact newer equipment may cause. Matt expressed concerns about the recent FCC changes to power density output, as allowed to cell phone companies. Any increase to the power could lead to public safety concerns with interference on the towers.

*WMLEC* – Steve Kozloski noted the RapidComm Trailer was deployed recently as a resource at several area events.

*CMED*: No Report.

MSP – Matt Barstow noted the radio console upgrades should be completed by next week.

*Other* – No Report.

**Budget Review** – Once Raine has the final costs for the CMED project and the COMU Go Kits costs for the connecting cables, she will be able to finalize the FFY17 funds remaining.

The FFY18 contracts are ready to get started, and the following two can start immediately.

- (I) The Video Downlink Project-\$50,000.00
- (II) Satellite Internet for BSCO Mobile Command Unit-\$35,000.00

**New Business** – Lindsay Stromgren reported on the legal debate between Eastern/Western Mass. EMS at the MIFOG meeting, regarding the use of (NIFOG) tac channels by public safety for helicopter communications in western mass. For now the MIFOG helicopter communications policy will remain as part of the MIFOG guide update.

Lindsay reported on a recent incident, where the MIFOG policy was not followed, leading to a channel miscommunication between dispatch and the helicopter company.

The meeting highlighted the apparent communication systems differences in use between eastern/western mass.
