Project Updates

WMLEC Gap Solutions – The specialty cables were delivered, and are in the process of being installed.

CMED Hovey Hill – Motorola is waiting on National Grid and Eversource to meet prior to proceeding with the project. Both companies own the towers in question. Raine noted there are some delays with issuing the PO from MAPC due to contract considerations desired by Motorola. Raine noted the project will need an extension of FFY17.

Holcomb Road Project – Green Mountain Company completed the work. Robert Garriepy noted he was happy with the work completed.

COMU Go Kits –The bid is due on April 22, 2019. Raine will have more information for the next meeting.

Western Mass Interoperable Systems Update

Berkshire County – Tom Grady noted they are waiting on the results of the 911 Development Grant request, which will enable Berkshire County to complete their multi-year project. They have hired a consultant to map all of the towers, using drone technology.

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Franklin County – Walter Tibbets noted that Leyden and Colrain has some recent incompatibility issues, that may have been resolved by now.

Hampshire County - No updates.

WMLEC – The spare microwaves dishes currently housed in Monson will need to be moved before the building were they are being stored is torn down. Steve Kozloski had asked Raine what is the procedure for selling/giving away the equipment. Raine noted due to the cost the items likely can be sold or given to another Homeland Security Council or other interested government agency. Raine will share the details and equipment list with the subcommittee and interested parties once Steve Kozloski provides the specifications of the equipment.

CMED: Bob noted that CMED is waiting on National Grid and Eversource to meet regarding the two towers before Motorola can go ahead with the project.

MSP – No updates

Budget Review – Raine has requested an extension of the FFY17 CMED project.

The FFY18 projects are ready to move forward.

FFY2018 BCSO Mobile Unit Satellite Internet

Jason provided an updated satellite quote of \$32,687.00, and the funding is approved up to \$35,000.00. Raine will send the project justification to EOPSS for approval.

FFY2018 Video Downlink Upgrades

It was agreed to request an estimate for the existing units to be repaired and upgraded. The project will be completed in stages. The first step will be an assessment of the equipment.

Motion: Tom Grady moved to approve the project up to \$50,000.00, and to allow the subcommittee to make incremental steps to get the equipment functioning and operational again. Butch Garriety seconded. Voted unanimously in favor.

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Raine will write the project justification and seek EOPSS and SIEC approval so the project can move forward.

New Business – Huntington has some miscellaneous equipment left over from a 2004 project. Robert Garriepy will provide Raine with a list of the available equipment to make a determination.

Tom noted that the Berkshire County PSAPS are taking wireless calls. They are experiencing some challenges with an increase in calls from outside their service area.
