# **COVID-19 Response AAR**

The Western Region Homeland Security Advisory Council (WRHSAC) will conduct an After-Action Report (AAR) of the region's response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The AAR will focus on how the COVID-19 response worked (or did not work) at the local, county and Western Mass level (Berkshire, Franklin, Hampshire and Hampden Counties). The outcome will identify things we can change to make the next response work better.

The first step of this project is to develop a scope of services to procure a consultant to complete the AAR and Improvement Plan (IP). The scope development is in the form of a strategic planning process to identify who should be involved in the AAR/IP process and what issues should be the focus of the AAR/IP. WRHSAC has engaged the Berkshire Regional Planning Commission's (BRPC) Public Health Program to facilitate this planning process.

WRHSAC's timeline for the project is to complete the AAR focus and scope of services for a consultant by early October 2021, with a consultant engaged by mid-December 2021. The AAR will get underway in January 2022. WRHSAC expects the AAR process will take nine months up to a year. It is anticipated that focused and region-wide interviews and conferences will be part of the AAR process to gather information from the region's responders. A final region-wide AAR/IP conference will be held to publicize the outcome and discoveries.

WRHSAC will use the IP to direct projects in the coming years. Thank you for your participation.
